- 4. **Series** Development of Manufacturing Drawings: From your 3D files, we produce: Detailed drawings, Bills of materials (BOM), Definition of weld types and locations, Optimization of bending/cutting to reduce manufacturing costs.
- 5. Pelivery of a Complete, Production-Ready File: We deliver a complete package: DXF STEP PDF, ready for production or subcontracting.




